- 1. the Applicant, Godfrey Phillips India Ltd. was incorporated in India in the year 1936 and is currently the second largest manufacturer and dealer of cigarettes and cigarette products in India with an annual turnover exceeding 2200 crores. The Applicant has two major stakeholders, namely K.K. Modi Group and Phillip Morris, U.S.A;
- 2. the Applicant and its marks are well-known worldwide having established successful operations on the international market in the Middle East, West Africa, Latin America, South East Africa and South East Asia;
- 3. the Applicant's TOP 20 mark was fully registered at the trademark registry in India since the 13th of April, 2005 under International Class 34 in respect of tobacco, raw or manufactured; tobacco products, namely cigars, cigarettes, cigarillos, tobacco for roll your own cigarettes, pipe tobacco, chewing tobacco, snuff tobacco, kretek; snus; tobacco substitutes (not for medical purposes); smokers' articles namely cigarette paper and tubes, cigarette filters, tobacco tins, cigarette cases and ashtrays, pipes, pocket apparatus for rolling cigarettes, lighters; matches. To date the said mark remains valid and subsisting;
- 4. the application for the mark TOP 20 is not made in bad faith, as alleged by the Opponent;
- 5. the Applicant's registration of the TOP 20 mark in Belize is honest and bona fide, after a search at the trade mark registry in Belize confirmed that there were no identical or similar marks found under International Class 34;
- the Applicant denies that its mark is similar with any earlier mark and denies that its goods are identical or similar to any earlier mark of the Opponent;
- 7. the opponent is not the registered proprietor of the mark TOP or any similar mark in Belize and has no legitimate right to oppose the use or registration of the TOP 20 mark in Belize;
- 8. the Applicant has a legitimate right to seek the registration of the TOP 20 mark in Belize having adopted the mark in Belize prior to any other entity and having established an excellent reputation in Belize through importation, sales, advertising and promotion of the TOP 20 brand of cigarettes in Belize;
- 9. the Opponent does not rely on any legitimate rights of ownership of any mark in Belize and has no such rights of ownership of any mark in Belize;
- 10. the TOP mark that the Opponent intends to rely on is descriptive hence it is not distinctive and the Applicant denies the Opponent's exclusive right to use same;
- 11. the Opponent cannot establish an earlier right or use of the said mark in Belize and the Opponent has no reputation of the said mark in Belize. The Applicant calls upon the Opponent to product documentary evidence in support of its claim;
- 12. the said mark or any similar mark is not well-known trade mark as the Opponent alleges and the Opponent is not entitled to protection under statute or otherwise. The Applicant calls upon the Opponent to produce documentary evidence in support of its claim;
- 13. there is no likelihood of confusion on the part of the public;
- 14. the Applicant therefore respectfully requests that the application to register the TOP 20 mark be accepted.
