Our Republic Technologies (NA) LLC company has also filed numerous applications for our ZIG ZAG trade mark in various Caribbean countries and are pending the issuance of the corresponding certificates of registration
- 6) **REPUBLIC TECHNOLOGIES (NA)** LLC has used the ZIG + DEVICE trade mark during an extensive period of time around the world (since the 1800's) and there is no doubt that ZIG ZAG + DEVICE trade mark has acquired an important reputation.
- 7) **REPUBLIC TECHNOLOGIES (NA) LLC** is the proprietor of numerous trade mark ZIG ZAG registrations around the globe including various in the <u>United Kingdom</u>, namely: Registrations Nos. 303013, 1336159, 1205149 and 2384534.

- The company's application for the registration of the trade mark "Zig-Zag" in the Dominican Republic in October 2009, was opposed by North Atlantic Operating Company, Inc. of 3029 W. Muhammad Ali Blvd., P.O. Box 32980, Louisville, Kentucky 40212, United States of America. The said company did attempt to register the mark "Zig Zag" in Honduras recently and our company (REPUBLIC TECHNOLOGIES (NA)LLC) opposed the said application. Both matters are still pending.
- 11) The opponent North Atlantic Operating Company, Inc. argues that their products have been available in the international market

12) Our trade mark ZIG-ZAG is a prestigious trade mark, notorious and well-known in relation to the products it protects. We have skillfully gained a reputation for the highest quality products through our extensive global use of our trade mark where our consumers successfully relate the ZIG-ZAG products with excellent products.

Our trade mark is sufficiently distinct based on t simple search of the word "zig zag" in the top search engine GOOGLE

- Our trade mark is sufficiently distinct based on the use of the device if the "Zouave" (French soldier). A simple search of the word "zig zag" in the top search engine GOOGLE produces a hit to REPUBLIC TECHNOLOGIES (NA)

 LLC website http://www.zigzag.com/ and to REPUBLIC TECHNOLOGIES (NA) LLC following website http://www.zigzagpapers.com/index.php which all the more evidences the popularity of the brands of REPUBLIC TECHNOLOGIES (NA)LLC.
- The company <u>REPUBLIC TECHNOLOGIES (NA) LLC</u> respectfully requests BELIPO to refuse the opposition and to allow our trade mark application to proceed to the registration stage by granting the corresponding certificate of registration. We hereby reserve the right to adduce further grounds in support of our response to the Opposition and to provide further details of registrations and prior use of our trade mark world wide.

WHEREFORE the Applicant prays that its applications be registered because, inter alia, the ZIG ZAG trademark dilutes the



trademarks.
