

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Registrar is in receipt of a notice of opposition filed by COCO PLUM ISLAND RESORT LTD., of 1 Jetty Pier Road, Dangriga, Stann Creek District, Belize, against Trade Mark Application No. 4475.07, filed on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2007, by Great Belize Productions (The Applicant), of 17 Regent Street, Belize City, Belize, for the registration of the following trade mark, as proprietor thereof:



The Opponent opposes the above Trade Mark Application on the grounds that:

- the above mark resembles a registered mark for similar goods and services i.e. COCOPLUM A RESORT COMMUNITY Design resulting in the likelihood of confusion and/or of association by the public being BZ No. 3446.05 dated January 30, 2006, which has been granted and in force until 17<sup>th</sup> October 2015, and as such, falls within the purview of Section 37 (2) (b) of the Trade Marks Act.
- 2. The Opponent has prior to registration and at least for the past 7 years, used the registered mark in its advertising and marketing of its business namely the Hotel/Tourism Industry as can be evidenced on its website <a href="https://www.cocoplumcay.com">www.cocoplumcay.com</a>. As such, the Opponent also opposes pursuant to Section 37 (3) since the Applicant's mark is similar and alternately, if the goods and services are not found to be similar, by long usage, the earlier mark has gained a reputation, and use of the later mark would be detrimental to the distinctive character or reputation of the Opponent's mark.
- 3. "Coco Plum" has been the name of the island for centuries and as such, is historical and highly distinctive. Both businesses are located in one of the smallest (if not the smallest) Districts of Belize, namely Stann Creek with an estimated population of 24,548 people, which represents 10.3% of the total population of Belize, and as such, and despite the registered mark's national recognition, the applicant's proposed mark is already confused by a majority of residents and visitors in that locality who are almost all familiar with the opponent's registered mark.
- 4. Coco Plum Island Resort Ltd. has also been incorporated and the Companies Registrar has not given permission to incorporate any other entity belonging to the Applicant with a similar name.
- The Opponent's business is duly registered with the Belize Tourism Board and remits due Hotel Accommodation Taxes and License Fees.
- 6. While not the exact classes, Classes 35 and 36 contain elements of the Classes the Opponent has sought protection for, namely hotel business and rentals and are thus, similar to the registered classes namely, Class 43 for hotel and hotel reservation. There exists visual and aural similarity through its dominant components namely: identical words (all in Roman characters), colours, drawings and perceptual connotations when compared and taken as a whole.
- 7. In addition to its national and locally renowned reputation, by virtue of the International Segment of its business, the said mark has also gained notoriety internationally *inter alia*, as one of the world's leading wedding destinations and as such, is entitled to protection under the Trade Marks Act.

The Applicant is required to submit a response to this notice, to the Registrar, no later than 30 days from the date of publication of this notice.














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
