

GENERAL INFORMATION

What the Seminar is About	The increasing globalization of trade is making it more and more necessary to acquire an international application for the protection of industrial designs in a timely and cost-effective manner. The Hague system of international registration of industrial designs was created to meet this need. At present, the Hague system is governed by the 1934 Act, the 1960 Act and the 1999 Act of <i>The Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs</i> . The most recent Act of the Hague Agreement, the Geneva Act, adopted in July 1999, became operational on April 1, 2004.
	The Hague system is simple, inexpensive and efficient. It enables its users to obtain protection for their industrial designs in several countries by means of a single application made with the International Bureau of WIPO. Currently 38 States are members of the Hague Union, which attracts more and more users. Thus a good knowledge of the system is important for those working in the field of industrial designs, whether in industry or in the private sector.
	The seminar will be conducted by staff members of WIPO and an invited speaker. It aims at increasing awareness and practical knowledge of the system amongst actual and potential users, whether in industry or in private practice. It will cover all aspects of the Hague system including legal and practical matters (main features and advantages of the system, different steps in procedure, etc.) as well as the latest trends in the field of international industrial design registration bringing together the most diverse national and regional registration procedure with potential worldwide effect.
Who Should Attend	Independent and in-house industrial property agents (paralegals as well as attorneys) who file applications for international industrial design registrations and who administer such registrations. The seminar will deal with all aspects of the international registration procedure and address in detail relevant administrative and legal questions.
Where and When	The seminar will be held at the headquarters of WIPO, 34, chemin des Colombettes, Geneva (Switzerland), on Wednesday, July 7, 2004. It will commence at 9.30 a.m. (registration from 9 a.m.), and will end around 5 p.m.
Languages	The seminar will be conducted in English and French with simultaneous interpretation between the two languages.
